#### **ORGANISATION**

- Petra Enterprises Pty Ltd, Spica Nominees Pty Ltd and Sahris Pty Ltd, together form the legal entity that is the NVR Registered Training Organisation. The entity is a business partnership between three private companies that are trustees for three family trusts. Petra Enterprises and Spica Nominees each have 40% of the partnership and Sahris has the remaining 20%. One director from each company is active in the RTO, and the three directors act as equal partners in RTO decision making which occurs by consensus.
- Petra Enterprises Pty Ltd has two directors, Mr Paul Morgan and Ms Natalie Morgan. Mr Paul Morgan is the Chief Executive Officer of the RTO as well as a trainer and assessor. Ms Natalie Morgan has no role in or influence over the RTO.
- Spica Nominees Pty Ltd has three directors, Ms Lesley West, Mr Richard West and Ms Claire West. Ms Lesley West is Director of Organisation Consulting for the RTO as well as a trainer and assessor. The other two directors have no role in or influence over the RTO.
- Sahris Pty Ltd has one director, Ms Rebecca Herbertson, and two shareholders, Ms Rebecca Herbertson and Mr Stewart Herbertson. Ms Rebecca Herbertson is Director of Training and Compliance for the RTO as well as a trainer and assessor.
- The RTO provides both consulting services and training services through its three permanent staff the directors with additional casual trainers employed as needed. The RTO also has a contract bookkeeper who reports to the CEO.
- The RTO has issued 49 qualifications in the past year and 347 Statements of Attainment. There are 35 current enrolments in Queensland (5), New South Wales (3), the Northern Territory (2) and Western Australia (25).
- Sources of revenue for the RTO include User Choice Traineeship funding, National Job Services Australia funding for Job Futures, Indigenous Employment Panel funding for Indigenous learners and Enterprise Based Productivity Places Program funding for existing workers. Only six students have paid their own fees in the past five years of operation.
- Fees are charged per unit and students are invoiced once they have enrolled. The RTO invoices \$1000 at a time in accordance with Option 3 for protecting student fees.
- No training or assessment is delivered through a partnership with another organisation.
